Qualifying Criteria: ALL 5 of these MUST be met to be considered for the scholarship. If any one of these minimum qualifiers are not met, your application will not be eligible.

1. **Only members of NROCC can apply for this scholarship.**
*****Please see page 4 for restrictions regarding membership eligibility.*****
2. **This is for the pursuit of post-secondary/post high school education such as Associate's, Bachelor's, Master's, PhD, JD, etc. Certain structured certification/vocational programs may be considered as well.**
(Please contact committee co-chairs for clarification of eligible certification/vocational programs prior to submitting application packet).
3. **Applicant must be already accepted or attending an institution of higher learning to receive the award** (recent high school graduates must send in a copy of their acceptance letter).
4. **There is no minimum GPA requirement;** however, you cannot be on any type of academic probation or disciplinary action at your institution. Finalists may be required to provide a final transcript of the semester.
5. **Application is due on or before April 30, 2026.**

Submitting the application

Please submit the following to be considered for the NROCC scholarship:

1. **Sections 1-4 of Application (Personal Info, Academic Info, Activities & Interests, and Short Essay)**
 2. **One Letter of recommendation-please see guidelines on PAGE 4 regarding format of letter of recommendation.** Letter can be from your high school/college faculty, counselor, work supervisor, community service organizer, church committee chair, etc. (No family members, church board member, or scholarship committee member).
 3. **Unofficial or official transcript showing MOST RECENT GPA.**
 4. **College Acceptance Letter** (ONLY for recent high school graduates and college applicants with no established GPA). (Certification/vocational program will need to provide an acceptance letter or class schedule).
 5. **Web link showcasing any performing arts, sports clips, or other areas of talent (optional)**
 6. **Return two (2) EXACT copies of application to: scholarships@nrocc.org.**
 7. ***ONCE THESE ITEMS HAVE BEEN SUBMITTED, A ZOOM INTERVIEW WILL BE SCHEDULED. IN ADDITION TO THE INTERVIEW QUESTIONS, YOU WILL ANSWER AN ADDITIONAL QUESTION OF YOUR CHOICE FROM A LIST GIVEN AFTER WE RECEIVE YOUR WRITTEN APPLICATION. 4. **List and briefly describe any work experience within the last 3 years.** Be sure to include the employer, position held, and dates of employment. Also, include a summary of your work responsibilities with the employer(s).

ESSENTIAL ESSAY QUESTION. Each applicant must answer the below question. Feel free to use scriptural references in your responses

An increasingly discussed opinion is that many churches are beginning to look more like the world and are less concerned about reflecting the true character of Christ. Do you believe this opinion to be true or false? Please explain your stance and feel free to support your position using examples from pop culture, social media, scripture, and the modern-day church.

Application is due on or before April 30, 2026.

NOTE: Selected scholarship recipient(s) will submit a written paragraph to be published on the value of the scholarship award in their academic pursuits.

Letter of Recommendation Guidelines

Introduction: Who you are, your relationship to the applicant, and why you are recommending them to receive this scholarship.

Relationship: How do you know the applicant? How long have you known the applicant?

Recommendation: A clear statement on why you highly recommend this applicant. Give specific examples where the candidate exhibited one or more of the following values: **humility, excellence, compassion for people, dependence on God, integrity, or passion for Christ.**

Signature: Full name, title and signature.

Since NROCC is a nonprofit organization, members of the NROCC Board of Directors and/or the NROCC Scholarship Committee and their respective family members are ineligible to apply for the scholarship. If anyone in your family desires to apply but falls into one of these categories, please contact the committee co-chairs for further guidance).
